- The group welcomed Graham to his first meeting
- Ronnie and Doreen were thanked for assisting the practice relocate to its new home

Dardsley Update by Practice Manager

- The practice closed for the last time at 410 Leyland Road on Friday 15 March, moved into Dardsley on Saturday 16 March, prepared the site for opening on Sunday 17 March and successfully opened at Dardsley on Monday 18 March
- The Practice Manager paid tribute to the hard work of the staff team
- Some elements of the refurbishment are not yet completed, but should be resolved by the end of April:
 - Exterior Lostock Hall Medical Centre lit sign over the entrance (a temporary banner is in place in the meantime)
 - Glass covering for the entrance canopy
 - Graphics for the Reception Desk
 - Aluminium windows for the Waiting Room
 - Markings for the carpark
- Street signage adjoining the entrance gate will require a planning application. The Forum
 asked if hashing could be added on the road to encourage traffic not to block the
 entrance. This will be investigated at the same time
- Some teething issues with the new phone system were discussed. It is expected that
 most patients will prefer a system that tells them their place in the phone queue,
 although one patient has complained about it. No phone should now ring unattended,
 as staff can log out the phone when leaving their desk
- The Forum had a tour of the whole site. It was explained that rooms 8-16 in the
 extension block are not yet fully in service. Some rooms will be used for wellbeing
 courses, group consultations, Mindsmatter consultations, Quit Squad smoking cessation
 sessions, baby feeding and patient meetings with the Senior Receptionist or Practice
 Manager
- It is still the intention to establish a pharmacy in this part of the building
