# Patient Forum Membership

It was agreed that two or three additional members should be recruited. Cllr Carol Wooldridge declined an invite to join the Forum because of other commitments but offered to provide informal advice when needed.

## **Completion of Building Work**

The items highlighted as outstanding have now been completed:

- Lit signage over the entrance
- Glass covering for the entrance canopy
- Graphics for the Reception Desk
- Aluminium windows for the Waiting Room
- Markings for the carpark including disabled parking

The architect is in conversation with the planning department regarding a roadside sign next to the entrance gate.

### **New Clinics**

- In addition to Physio and Diabetic Eye-Screening clinics, the practice will soon be hosting Desmond Diabetes education meetings for patients with type 2 diabetes. A Diabetes Prevention clinic was piloted during June and is likely to be repeated
- Patients have been encouraged to host Wellbeing / Mindfulness classes hosted at the practice and run by fellow patients
- Further clinics will be hosted once additional rooms have been equipped
- Patient Forum members confirmed their support for Extended Access regular nurse/HCA clinic evening clinics on Tuesdays until 8.30pm starting from 2 July

- Saturday GP clinics should be made more widely known, not just on the website
  - Action: David to publicise on social media and waiting room screens
- Waiting Room screens should 'ping' when patients called in (sound been turned off by reception staff?).
  - Action: David to resolve
- Patients would like a clock in the Waiting Room
  - Action: David to arrange
- Waiting Room needs notice board and leaflet holder
  - Action: David to resolve
- Some confusion where to sign in on arrival
  - Action: David to investigate
- Patients with mobility aids find slope on exit from Waiting Room to consulting rooms a challenge
  - Action: David to seek advice
